The Deborah F. Sager Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)

SJH's NICU can now care for approximately 99 percent of the babies born to mothers in South Jersey.

The first of its kind in South Jersey Healthcare's service area, the SJH Neonatal Intensive Care Unit provides highly-specialized maternal fetal care for more babies, and smaller babies, enhancing the services of all SJH facilities.

- As a level IIIa nursery, the NICU is equipped to care for babies as young as 28 weeks, gestational age. These babies often weigh less than two pounds and battle multiple medical issues. In fact, SJH's NICU can now care for approximately 99 percent of the babies born to mothers in South Jersey.
- SJH is further developing pediatric services through a partnership with Nemours/Alfred I. duPont Hospital for Children.
- With the opening of the new NICU, SJH can now better serve the at-risk community by providing quality care, close to home.
