7th Annual Fashion Show & Fair a Success



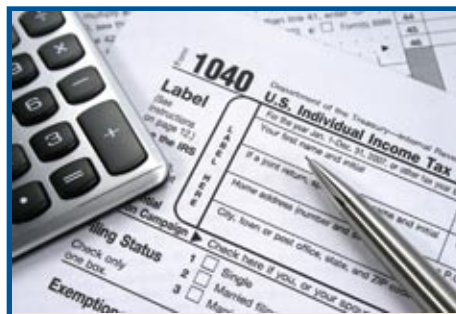

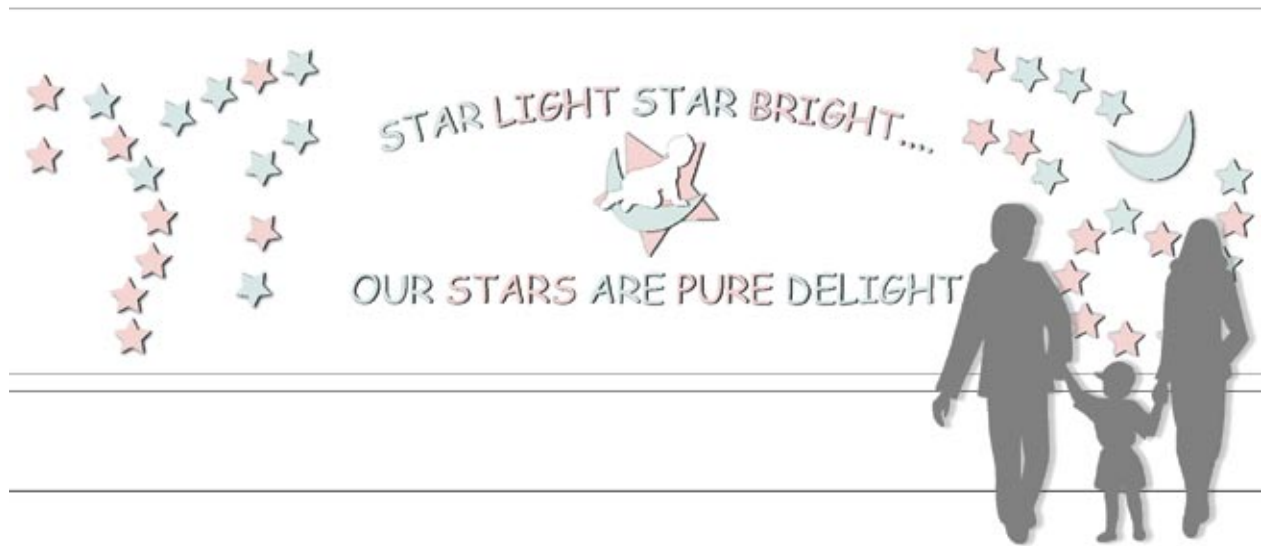

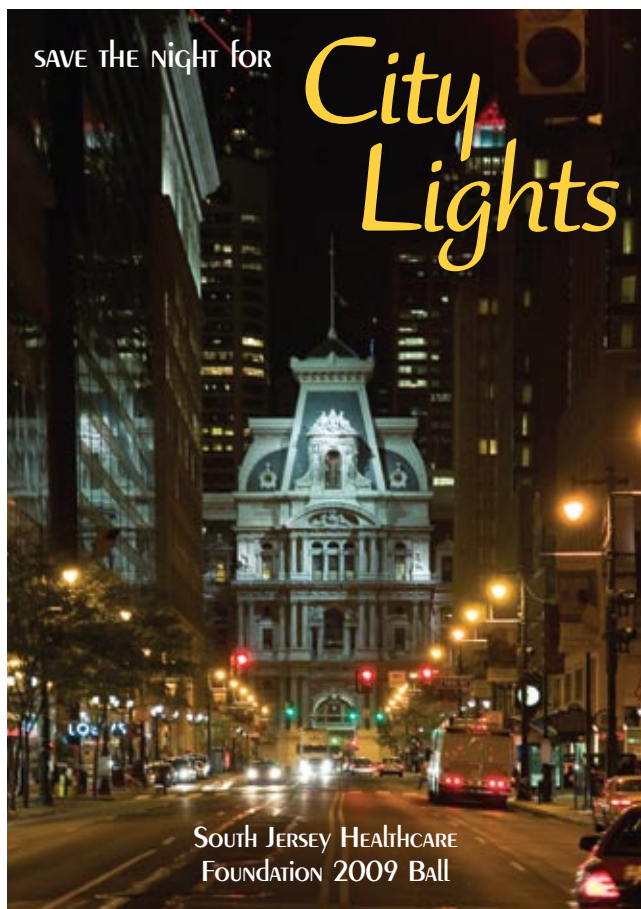
